 - c. Communication coordinator
 - d. Lunch/Event coordinator
 - e. "FRANS" coordinator, (friends, relatives, acquaintances, and neighbors)
 - f. Team leader
- 3) Schedule
 - a. One Month before Week One
 - i. Council Decision
 - ii. First Team Meeting
 - iii. Second Team Meeting
 - b. Monday-Tues of Week One:
 - i. Letter to congregation from Pastor/President
 - ii. Bulletin Announcement
 - iii. Newsletter Article
 - c. Week Two
 - i. Sunday:
 1. Temple talk by Team leader
 2. Sermon: By Pastor
 3. Prayer: By Prayer coordinator
 - ii. Later that week:
 1. Team Meeting
 2. Prayer
 - d. Week Three
 - i. Temple Talk by FRANS coordinator
 - ii. Ushers pass out intention cards and invitation cards
 1. Intention cards: Includes the name of the person being considered for invitation and the member who is considering doing the inviting.
 2. Invitation cards – what the person will use to aid in the invitation.
 - iii. Prayer team prays for those being invited.
 - e. Week Four
 - i. Temple Talk by someone about the experience of being invited and becoming a part of God's community at LoL.
 - ii. Another encouragement to participate.
 - iii. Team Meeting
