Confession and Absolution:

A: By the grace and mercy of God, Jesus Christ was given to die for us, and for His sake, God forgives us all our sins. Forgiven by Christ, we are called to love and serve all those who struggle for daily life and hope. Amen.

Prayer of Day:

Gracious and merciful God, like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, we often walk through life discouraged, fearful, and overwhelmed by grief. In Jesus Christ, you have come to walk with us and be one with us. By your power to make all things new, sustain us on the journey. Open our eyes to recognize you walking with us. Amen.

Prayers of Intercession:
