#### Yankton attractions

Lewis & Clark Lake, formed by Gavins Point Dam is arguably Yankton's main attraction. Trinity has arranged a free **tour of the Dam**. ### Application for Voting Member to the Twelfth Triennial Convention July 13-15, 2026 in Des Moines, Iowa

A note on the Triennial from Churchwide: The budget for the 2023 Triennial Convention was made for the event to be held in 2020, in Phoenix. Due to Covid, the Triennial was rescheduled for 2021 and held online. When the 2023 Convention was planned, again for Phoenix, the budget was not updated for inflation. There were fewer participants and higher fees from hotel and convention center, resulting in a deficit. The Churchwide Board voted to hold a virtual Convention in Des Moines July 13-15. Voting delegates from the statewide organizations will virtually join the convention proceedings, and will not be reimbursed for expenses.

The Churchwide executive board encourages SWOs (Synodical Women's Organizations) to meet within regions. South Dakota's three delegates will meet with delegates from North Dakota (4) and Minnesota (35). Voting members will attend pre-Convention virtual practice sessions to become familiar with the process. The National Executive Board understands this decision will be a disappointment.

A note from our Synodical Presidents: At the Business meeting of our Synodical Convention on June 19, we will need to elect two more delegates (the President is the third one). If you have any questions, please call Lois or Sherry, and they will try to answer your questions.

Final Note: Only one (1) person per unit! The nominating committee has very strict rules.

Every year when I attend our South Dakota Synodical Women of the ELCA Convention, I learn things through the speakers, displays, and talking to the other women from around the state about what their congregations are doing.

This year I will share with you the work of ELCA World Hunger and Disaster Response.

Overseas, we usually work with Companion Synod churches or Lutheran World Relief, Lutheran World Federation of Church World Service to make sure that we aren't just sending money, but following through with local partners. In the United States, including in South Dakota, money is channeled through carefully screened grants to churches and ministries making a difference in their setting.

Lutheran Disaster Response is organized to be more nimble, so as to respond quickly to disasters soon after they happen. When you give to a specific disaster in the United States or overseas, funds are directed to that need with no administrative costs, but it is very important to know that undesignated disaster money is vital to have on hand so that there is no waiting period for money to flow in before people are on the ground, helping organize the work on the ground where fires, floods, hurricanes, tornadoes and other catastrophes occur.

Come to Yankton this summer for our convention! I look forward to seeing you — it is like a family reunion where new people are always welcome!
